Color and Shape Games Printable

You can use these color shape cards in a variety or ways to help your little one work on learning their shapes and colors! Here are some examples of some fun games you can play! Get creative and have fun!

Matching Game

Print off 2 pages of each set of cards that you want to use so that you have two matching cards. For beginners, start with only one set. Cut the cards out on the lines. Mix them up and flip them upside down. Take turns flipping them over looking for matches.

As your child gets familiar with the shapes and colors, you can begin adding additional sets of cards to make it more challenging.

**For this game, you may want to print your cards out on cardstock or glue them to a piece of construction paper before cutting them out to prevent them from being see through. You can also laminate your cards to make them last longer.

Bingo

To play Bingo, you'll need one copy of cards from sets 1-4 and a few Bingo cards. Shuffle the cards and place them face down. Give each player a bingo card (each one is different). Flip a card from the deck over and have players check their cards for it. If they have one, cover it up. First one to get four in a row wins!


For an advanced version of this game, don't show your little one the card in the deck. Instead, call it out, "red circle" and have them check their cards for it.

Color Forting


Have your child sort the cards from Sets 1-4 by color using the color name cards on Set 5.




Color Shape Cards Set 1




Color Shape Cards Set 2
